Ditch your disposables and make a difference

There is currently a lot of media interest in single use plastics and the damaging impact they are having on the environment. The European Union has now announced that all plastic packaging will be reusable or recyclable by 2030 in an urgent plan to rid the continent of damaging plastics. China has announced that they will cease accepting imports of foreign waste products that are to be recycled. The UK simply doesn't have the infrastructure to deal with plastic waste so action needs to be taken and now.

Harfield want to help you make a difference by encouraging the use of our 100% recyclable polycarbonate tableware over the use of disposables and non-recyclable plastics such as melamine.

The BBC reported that it's likely that about 10 million tonnes of plastic currently ends up in the oceans each year. The hard-wearing qualities of most plastics mean that some items can take hundreds of years to biodegrade.

Recycling service

In 2018, our pledge to our customers is to recycle all Harfield polycarbonate tableware to help you do your bit to save the world!

Replacing disposables, melamine & crockery with polycarbonate will reduce waste sent to landfill, saving costs of waste disposal & environmental cost of landfill.

All you need to do is contact us at info@harfieldtableware.co.uk and let us know what you would like to return. We will then send you an authorisation label to put on top of the boxes being returned. Then you simply return the items to us and we will do the rest. You will receive a certificate thanking you for choosing Harfield tableware and for helping save the environment!

Recycled plastic is widely used within the UK. It is used in construction products such as drainage pipes and scaffolding boards. Also in jetties, fences and signs as well as in street furniture, bins, planters and tree ties. Recycled plastic is durable, cost competitive and resistant to vandalism.

We can arrange for collection of the items to be recycled, but there will be a collection charge of £13.50 per 25kgs. If you have lots of items for recycling, we can send you a cage for filling. The cost of collection for the cage is £70.

We are sorry, but we can only recycle items that have the following names on the base: **Harfield, Roltex, AMC, Akvila and Malko.**

Full details of how to arrange the collection will be sent with the recycling label. Your recycled polycarbonate will then be sorted, shredded and washed and turned into a granulate. Polycarbonate is different to other plastics and will be reused again in the UK.

Melamine products are not recyclable and so we cannot recycle these. If we do receive melamine products then we will have to return them to you at a charge of £7.50 or dispose of them for you for £13.50 per 25kgs. We can accept back more than one box at a time. The £13.50 cost is per 25kgs. As an average, 25kgs is 200 x 23cm plates.

(All collection costs exclude VAT)

Our 020 200ml fluted tumbler could last an average of 5 or more years if washed correctly.

If you use water cooler disposable 200ml/7oz tumblers at **1.5p each*** then over a year (260 work days) for 100 employees you would use a minimum of **26,000 tumblers** costing **£390**. That's £3.90 per employee for the year based on one tumbler per person each day. But would they only use one tumbler a day or have one per cup of water?

Buy Harfield 200ml/7oz tumblers at **97p each**** then over a year (260 work days) for 100 employees you would use **100 tumblers** costing **£97** plus housekeeping. That's £0.97 per employee for the year.
